**SCHEDULING – IMPORTANT INFO**

**CAPTAIN'S RESPONSIBILITY:** If you have special scheduling circumstances – **time conflicts or not being able to play a week** – write those special requests on your roster form when registering. We are able to accommodate nearly every special request – **if we know in advance**. Once the schedule is completed it is nearly impossible to change the schedule with so many teams involved in our leagues. Please review potential conflicts prior to the season.

**SUNDAY CO-ED SCHEDULE - "We work around scheduled Packers Games"**

We will avoid scheduling volleyball games when the Packers play. The current Packers schedule will allow us to get our Fall volleyball season played and finished by the Christmas holiday. However, NFL rules allow for the changing of football game times late in the season. If this occurs and involves the Packers, it is very unlikely that we will be able to change our schedule and conflicts may occur.

When the Packers play at Noon we play from approximately 3:40-8:30 p.m., when the Packers play at 7:30 p.m. we typically play from approximately 1:00-7:10 p.m. and the dreaded 3:15 Packers game is the worst for scheduling as we are typically limited to an approximate Noon-3:00 p.m. abbreviated schedule.

**THURSDAY WOMEN'S SCHEDULE**

The Packers play on Thursday, October 20 and we will not be able to avoid this conflict. With Thanksgiving eliminating one available Thursday we need to play on all Thursdays to complete the league prior to the Christmas holiday. This is one Packers conflict we will not be able to avoid.

When we form the leagues we are looking for the best balance based on players listed on your roster and previous results involving your team. New teams are placed based on info we gather from the roster and often from the captain. We are very fortunate to have a significant number of teams enter our volleyball program which helps to form leagues matching similar levels of talent and competitiveness.
